Federation Facility Update

We continue to follow the advice of the Saskatchewan Chief Medical Officer of Health, adjusting our working conditions to coincide with the phases of the Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan. Holding meetings and hosting events will only be done if it can be done safely and while following the social distancing and other preventative measures, as recommended by public health officials.

- All STF facilities are open. The Regina office is by appointment only.
- External bookings from now until the end of November will be considered if appropriate physical distancing can be met.
- All visitors who enter the building are required to wear a mask.
- All staff are required to wear a mask while meeting with visitors.
- Executive, committee and board members are required to wear a mask in all common areas, but may remove it once inside the meeting room
- Masks will be made available for visitors who do not have a mask

If you are planning to visit a Federation office, please perform this self-screening before your arrival:

1. Are you experiencing any general symptoms of COVID-19 or feeling at all unwell?
2. Have you tested positive for COVID-19?
3. Have you been in close contact as identified by the Medical Health Officer with persons who have tested positive for COVID-19?
4. Have any members in your household tested positive for COVID-19?
5. Have you travelled outside of Saskatchewan, to a restricted location or otherwise, or have you travelled outside of Canada within the previous 14 days?

If you answered YES to any of these questions, please delay your visit.
