



Current Collective Bargaining Timeline

OCTOBER 2018	Plenary session at Councillor Conference during which councillors will be asked to identify priorities for the upcoming round of negotiations.
NOVEMBER 2018	Member survey distributed to help inform the setting of priorities for the upcoming round of negotiations.
DECEMBER 2018	Draft proposals developed based on the <i>Principles to Guide the Proposal Development Process</i> , survey data and review of past proposals and resolutions.
JANUARY 2019	STF Executive review and provide feedback on <i>Draft Proposals for Teachers' Consideration</i> .
JANUARY/ FEBRUARY 2019	Member focus groups convened to refine the draft proposals.
FEBRUARY 2019	Draft proposals revised based on feedback from the STF Executive, focus groups, Councillor Conference and the member survey.
MARCH 2019	Letter of intent to open negotiations and letter to specify the dispute resolution mechanism sent to the Government-Trustee Bargaining Committee.
MARCH/ APRIL 2019	<i>Draft Proposals for Teachers' Consideration</i> debated in mini-councils.
APRIL 2019	<i>Draft Proposals for Teachers' Consideration</i> and bargaining resolutions debated at the Annual Meeting of Council.
MAY 2019	<i>Proposals for Teachers' Provincial Collective Bargaining</i> finalized based on outcome of debate at Annual Meeting of Council.
MAY 2019	Bargaining begins.
JUNE 2019	Bargaining continues.
