PENSION AND BENEFIT PLANS

The Federation provides comprehensive benefit programs that support the physical, mental and financial well-being of you and your family. Our focus is providing a sustainable, valuable benefits package so you can focus on building a healthy, happy life and career.

Your Benefits

As a member of the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation, you are eligible for a wide range of benefits while employed under a continuing, replacement or temporary contract of employment. These benefits include:

Plans administered by the STF:

- Health Plan
- Pension Plan
- Disability Plan
- Member and Family Assistance Plan
- Optional Life Insurance (Portaplan)

Plans administered by the Saskatchewan Teachers' Superannuation Commission:

- Dental Plan
- Group Life Insurance Plan

How to Enrol

To take advantage of these benefits, a completed Enrolment form signed by you and your employing school board must be submitted to the Federation. These forms can easily be obtained from either your school board or the Federation website.

Please be aware that the information you provide upon enrolment will be shared with the Saskatchewan Teachers' Superannuation Commission. It's important to note that whenever you sign a new contract of employment, a new Enrolment form needs to be submitted.

If your personal information changes, if you take a leave of absence or if you decide to leave the teaching profession, please make sure to complete and return the STF Change of Information form. Alternatively, you can update your name and contact details online by logging in to the MySTF section of the Federation website.

When Coverage Begins

Your health and dental plan coverage begins after you have completed 20 full or partial days of teaching service while you are on a contract of employment. Once enrolled in the Plan, Green Shield Canada will send you an email with your digital GSC card and instructions on how to register for GreenShield+, the user-friendly app and website that lets users access benefit plan information, view eligible coverage, claim history, and submit and track claims.

All other benefits begin the first day of your contract of employment.

PLANS ADMINISTERED BY THE STF



STF Members' Health Plan

The Members' Health Plan is here to provide coverage for a wide range of medical expenses while you're on a contract of employment. This means that you, your spouse and your dependants can rest easy knowing that eligible prescription drugs, vision and other health-care expenses, as well as emergency out-of-country medical expenses, are taken care of.

The Members' Health Plan is fully funded by the provincial government, based on a fixed percentage of teachers' salaries as negotiated through the provincial collective bargaining process. The Plan is insured by Green Shield Canada and the STF is responsible for Plan design, management and administration.

Once enrolled in the Plan, you can take advantage of the helpful digital health tools available in GreenShield+ and enjoy the convenience of registering for direct deposit. Member and Family Assistance Plan

As valued members, all teachers in Saskatchewan and their family members have exclusive access to the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation Member and Family Assistance Plan. DISABILITY

STF Disability Plan

If a sickness or injury prevents you from working, the Teachers' Long-Term Disability Plan is here to support you. After your sick leave ends, eligible teachers can receive tax-free disability benefits and access rehabilitation services. Because you pay the premiums, all benefits are tax-free. It's a just-in-case support that helps you get back to a healthy, happy life and career.

PENSION

STF Pension Plan (STRP)

As a new teacher, you're automatically enrolled in the Saskatchewan Teachers' Retirement Plan. Each month, a portion of your salary will go towards your pension, deducted by your school division. The provincial government contributes to the Plan based on the current collective agreement.

When you retire, you'll receive a monthly pension paid for your lifetime. The amount is determined by a formula that takes into account your earnings and years of service. The STRP offers a reliable pension benefit which not only helps to recognize your dedication as a teacher, but also provides you with a solid foundation of future retirement income.

Voluntary Contributions

You can save even more for retirement by making voluntary contributions through payroll deductions or lump-sum contributions. Voluntary contributions are optional contributions to the pension plan that are separate from your regular teacher contributions. These contributions do not increase your monthly teacher pension but do

provide extra income for your retirement. They are invested in the pension plan's investment funds, meaning your contributions benefit from the pension fund's net rate of return. When you retire, you can choose to transfer these funds to a personal RRSP or receive them as a taxable lump sum.

OPTIONAL LIFE INSURANCE

STF Optional Life Insurance (Portaplan)

The Federation is proud to offer optional term life insurance, Portaplan, to our members. Portaplan is a non-profit plan that offers affordable coverage at competitive rates. Participation is voluntary and if you purchase optional term life insurance, coverage can continue after your contract of employment ends, you change careers or move to another country.

Why Participate in Portaplan?

- Portaplan offers life, accident and dependant life insurance in addition to the mandatory Teachers' Group Life Insurance Plan provided through the Saskatchewan Teachers' Superannuation Commission.
- Available in units of \$20,000 to a maximum of \$600,000 (30 units).
- Portaplan can be an affordable alternative to mortgage insurance.
- **First and Second Year Members Special offer**
 - **If you apply for term life insurance in your first year of STF membership** you can be automatically approved for \$40,000 (two units) of life insurance with the first \$20,000 (one unit) of life insurance at no cost for the remainder of the policy year.
 - **If you apply for term life insurance in your second year of STF membership**, you can be automatically approved for the \$20,000 (one unit) of insurance.

Offers are also available for your spouse and children.

PLANS ADMINISTERED BY THE STSC



Dental Plan

The Teachers' Dental Plan provides coverage for a variety of dental expenses for you and your family while you're employed under contract. Funded by the provincial government and administered by the Saskatchewan Teachers' Superannuation Commission, the Plan is insured by Green Shield Canada.

Group Life Insurance

The Teachers' Group Life Insurance Plan offers peace of mind and financial protection for you and your family. Coverage is equal to twice the maximum salary for Class VI, rounded up to the nearest \$1,000. You are also covered for Accidental Death & Dismemberment in the same amount. Premiums are shared, the provincial government pays half and the other half is deducted from your pay.

If you are on a temporary contract of employment, your contract must be for 20 or more teaching days to be eligible for mandatory group life insurance.
