## All candidates must:

- Be a Canadian citizen and hold a Canadian passport valid until at least July 2024 at the time of application (proof that a passport application has been made will be accepted).
- Be a member of the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation and hold a valid teacher's certificate.
- Have completed at least five years of teaching in Canada by July 2023.
- Be in excellent health and be able to work in developing country conditions.
- Have high standards of professionalism and personal conduct.
- · Show evidence of flexibility and mature judgment.
- Be willing to put the team and project needs above personal needs.
