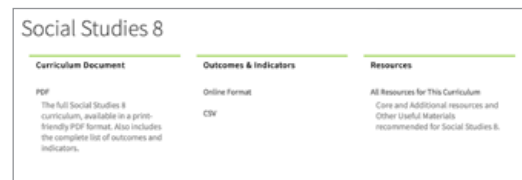
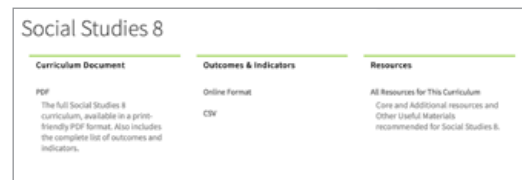


1 Start by selecting [Browse by Grade](#) or [Browse by Subject](#), then select your curriculum or grade level from the dropdown menu.

2 Click on [PDF](#) to view the complete curriculum or click [Online Format](#) under Outcomes & Indicators in order to reference a specific portion of the curriculum.

3 Click on [All Resources for This Curriculum](#) to see the approved Core & Additional Resources to support this curriculum, plus Other Useful Materials for the classroom.

4 [Core Resources](#) are listed first, followed by [Additional Resources](#), then [Other Useful Materials](#). Definitions are provided for each classification of resource (e.g., [What is a core resource?](#)).



5 Use the **filters on the left** to narrow your search. For instance, click on DR8.3 to see the resources that support that specific outcome. Click on any number of filters and click them again to deselect them.



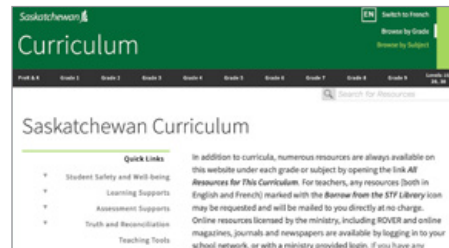
6 If **DOWNLOAD** appears beneath the title of the resource, it is available for free. If **WATCH** appears beneath the title, this is a video available for streaming through the Ministry's free ROVER video streaming service. You will have to enter your username and password. Contact networkservices@gov.sk.ca for assistance.



7 Click on the title of any item to see a pop-up of the detailed record. Anytime you see the **Borrow from the STF Library** link, click on it to see this item in the STF library catalogue. To request it, click the link at the bottom of the catalogue record. If available, it will be sent to your school, free of charge.



8 Under **Quick Links** on the curriculum home page, click on **Teaching Tools** and then on **ROVER** to search all of the videos available for streaming. ROVER also provides free access to the **National Film Board's CAMPUS** and to the **CBC's Curio** website, which now also includes videos from the National Geographic Channel.



9 Be sure to investigate other **Quick Links**. Under **Teaching Tools**, you will find links to free online **Magazines, Journals and Newspapers**. Under **Truth and Reconciliation**, you will find links to Supporting Reconciliation in Saskatchewan Schools as well as Treaty Education.



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
